- **NASN** has a "Sight for Students" program. - **New Eyes for the Needy** in Milburn/Short Hills will provide a voucher for basic prescription eyeglasses (not the exam) for children and adults in financial need throughout the US with household incomes at or below 100% of Federal Poverty guidelines.
